NASA West Virginia Space Grant Consortium 6th Annual Aviation Summer Camp June 11-13th, 2014

What: The NASA WV Space Grant Consortium (WVSGC) and Student Partnership for the

Advancement of Cosmic Exploration (SPACE) will conduct a three-day, two-night in-residence Aviation Summer Camp (Aviation Camp) on the West Virginia

University (WVU) campus in Morgantown, WV.

Who: Students completing seventh or eighth grade in West Virginia schools who are

dedicated to learning and willing to accept academic challenges and exhibit an aptitude for mathematics and science and a level of maturity commensurate with their

age group.

When: Camp dates will be June 11th, 12th and 13th, 2014.

Where: Camp attendees will be housed in the Evansdale Residential Complex (ERC) on the

WVU campus in Morgantown, WV.

Purpose: To expose and excite students to future career possibilities in Science, Technology,

Engineering, and Math (STEM). The camp will have three days full of engineering and science activities focused on the hands-on learning of aerospace-related

principles.

• The first day consists of aerospace/aviation related activities, including engaging presentations, tours of WVU Engineering Labs, and hands-on challenges.

• On the second day, the group will travel to the Challenger Learning Center

located on the campus of Wheeling Jesuit University in Wheeling, WV for an on-site mission simulation and other aerospace-related educational activities.

• On the third day, the camp will include hands-on projects with an aviation focus and presentations including one from WV Astronaut, Captain Jon McBride.

Additional Information:

Marcie Raol, a former middle school math and science teacher and organizer of this camp as well as numerous others, will supervise the Aviation Camp with the assistance of WVU student members of "SPACE". The **cost of this camp is \$300**, with a few scholarships available for students who qualify for free or reduced priced meals. The camp fee merely supplements the actual cost of the camp; other expenses are paid for through the NASA WVSGC. Travel to and from Morgantown, WV for participation in the aviation camp will be the responsibility of the attendee's parent or guardian.
